Hoping to see you at the Planning Breakfast on December 9th. Looking for a lot of input for future events we can attend and sponsor. New ideas are most welcome!!



Fifty times a winner

My 1968 Jaguar E-Type Roadster is featured in the August 2017 edition of Hemmings Motor News, both on the cover and in a four-page spread profile of my car (pages 48 through 51). The magazine hit the newsstands the first week of July, 2017, but hopefully there may be one or two left by the time you read this – or maybe you're a regular reader and saw it already. Either way, here's the background.

It all started 15 months ago. I had taken my car to Scottsdale, Ariz., at the end of March, 2016, to attend the first International Jaquar Festival. The intention was to drive it a little but mostly to show the car in the IJF Concours d'Elegance. On April 1, 2016, a gentleman approached me and said he was a photographer with Hemmings Publications and that he would like to take photographs of my car after the show at dawn, to catch the first light of the morning in the desert outside of Scottsdale. JAGUAR E-TYPE ZERO

Classic looks. Cutting edge tech. Based on a 1968 Series 1.5 Roadster, the Jaguar E-type Zero offers an iconic silhouette, while underneath an all-electric powertrain has it prepared for a sustainable future. Engineered by Jaguar Land Rover Classic, it has a slightly modified fascia, with LED headlights for efficiency, and revised instrumentation inspired by the original. It's lighter than its vintage sibling, and quicker, too — it moves from 0-62 mph in just 5.5 seconds — even though the power output was limited to better match the set-up of the original. This example will be on display at an event in London this weekend, and while specific production plans haven't been announced, curious parties are encouraged to contact Jaguar and register their enthusiasm.
