## FALL COLORS TOUR



#### XJ Collection Special Edition



The Jaguar XJ is undergoing a huge change next year and will be relaunched as a fully electric vehicle. But before then, the British automaker is releasing


a limited-edition version of the car that will only be available in the US. The XJ Collection Special Edition will be limited to just 300 examples and only sold in the US. After that all nine lives of the big cat will be used up - for now.

#### Jaguar Unlocks 8% More Range in the I-Pace

Jaguar told I-Pace owners that it is going to unlock "up to 8%" more range in their electric vehicles through a software update delivered through the work with their I-Pace-based racing series. If directly applied to Jaguar I-Pace's official EPA range of 234 miles, it would result in 252.7 miles of range — not bad for a software update.

#### Vegan Jaguar Interior

Jaguar now offers a completely vegan interior for their electric models. So instead of leather from animals, the interior will feature all-plant-based materials. (In the old days they called that cloth or velour, now it is vegan.) Whether any of it will be edible has not been released.




