ARUNDEL CASTLE UK JAGUAR SHOW

Arundel Castle is a restored and remodelled medieval castle in Arundel, West Sussex, England (close to Southampton for Americans, not close at all for British people). It was established by Roger de Montgomery on Christmas Day 1067 (or about five hundred years before anything ever happened in the U.S.). Roger became the first to hold the earldom of Arundel by the graces of William the Conqueror.

At the car show on castle grounds there were lots of Jaguars and a few Daimlers to see and it did not rain - that's a success in my book. Plus you could take a picture of your Jaguar with a real castle in the background - something you can not easily do in the United States unless you want to drive all the way to Biltmore Estate in North Carolina.


BRITISH RACE TRACKS

Our racing reporter John Shorrock visited two British race tracks this summer, Goodwood and Brands Hatch. While there were no Jaguars there at the time, there were plenty of other attractive and fast vehicles to admire.

Goodwood Circuit is a historic venue for both two- and four-wheeled motorsport in the United Kingdom. The 2.37mile circuit is situated near Chichester, West Sussex, close to the south coast of England, on the estate of Goodwood House, and completely encircles Chichester/Goodwood Airport. (For Americans, it is close to Southampton ...)

Brands Hatch Circuit is a motor racing circuit in West Kingsdown, Kent, England, United Kingdom (South East of London). Originally used as a grasstrack motorcycle circuit on farmland, it hosted 12 runnings of the British Grand Prix between 1964 and 1986 and currently hosts many British and International racing events.
